<b>Artistic Merit:</b> To have 'Artistic Merit' an image has to be more than just a record of the scene in front of you that your eyes initially see. Someone who can pick up a brush is not necessarily an artist and someone who can pick up a camera is not necessarily a photographer. You need to understand how light illuminates your subject and most importantly what you can do with it. Use your camera as a tool to analyse the scene and take time to think about how you can create something extra. Are there interesting elements for an abstract view, can you create mood with different shutter speeds, will it benefit from considerable or simple post production? Your work does not need to be overly technical, BUT it does need to convey that you have put thought into the final image whether it be with in camera techniques or post production work.
